Discounted Certificates for EBT, Medicaid or Low-Income Housing Assistance Recipients

The Neuter Now Program is a partnership between the City and County of Honolulu, the Hawaiian Humane Society and participating veterinary clinics that generously provide spay/neuter services at a greatly discounted fee. EBT cardholder, Medicaid cardholder or a member of a household receiving low-income housing assistance may purchase certificates at a reduced rate of \$20.

WHAT TO DO?

Submit a completed application to a Satellite City Hall location or to the Hawaiian Humane Society. A government issued ID and EBT card, Medicaid card or a current low-income housing voucher or documentation must be presented at time of submission.

Once your application is received and approved, your Neuter Now certificate will be mailed to you within ten (10) business days. A limit of ten (10) discounted certificates may be purchased per owner, per calendar year. If for any reason your application is denied, a refund will be issued.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Certificates are valid for ninety (90) days so pet owners are encouraged to contact a participating clinic to schedule an appointment for the spay/neuter procedure as soon as possible. Terms and Conditions

1. A list of participating veterinary clinics can be found in the Neuter Now brochure and online at HawaiianHumane.org. These clinics are generously providing spay/neuter services at a greatly reduced rate. Additional services may be required by some veterinarians, and the fees for the services vary. It is recommended that pet owners inquire about services and fees before making an appointment for surgery. A limit of ten (10) discounted certificates may be purchased per owner, per calendar year.
2. The Certificate includes the pre-surgical examination and surgery (including anesthesia and suture removal) in accordance with generally accepted veterinarian medical practices and procedures.
3. The Certificate does not include any additional charges a veterinarian may require such as lab work, vaccinations and pain medications. The Certificate also does not include medication or services required for the treatment of any post-surgical complications arising later than 24 hours after surgery.
4. Pet owners are encouraged to call a participating veterinary clinic to:
 - a) Verify participation in the Neuter Now Program.
 - b) Make an appointment for the pre-surgical examination and surgery.
 - c) Receive and comply with all instructions given by the veterinarian before and after surgery.
 - d) Ask about any additional fees.
5. Pet owners must present the Certificate with their EBT card, Medicaid card or a current low – income housing assistance notice/voucher and government-issued photo ID at the veterinarian's office for Neuter Now services.
6. Veterinarians may decide that animals may be unhealthy and not medically fit for surgery.
7. The Certificate is valid for three months from date issued. If your pet is unable to be sterilized within the three-month period, return the issued Certificate to the Hawaiian Humane Society or at a Satellite City Hall to apply for a refund.
8. Lost Certificates will not be replaced, refunded, nor are they transferable.
9. Owners must be 18 years of age or older.
