

# VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION ANIMAL CARE

#### TITLE:

Laundry Volunteer

# **MAJOR OBJECTIVE:**

Create a warm and comfortable environment for the animals in our care by preparing bedding and maintaining laundry loads to provide fresh and clean bedding, towels, toys and supplies.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- I. Assist with upkeep of laundry areas to ensure they are kept clean, tidy and fully stocked with necessary supplies.
- 2. Distribute clean items to various locations on campus.
- 3. Ensure laundry operations continue to flow effectively so there are clean and dry towels, bedding and washcloths for our staff to provide to the animals in our care.
- 4. Wash dirty bowls and other items such as toys, leashes and collars, and other items as needed.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Volunteers must be 18 years of age or older.
- 2. Ability to work independently.
- 3. Good communication skills.

#### TRAINING:

- I. Complete General Volunteer Orientation.
- 2. Interview with the Volunteer Services team.
- 3. Complete Hawaiian Humane 101 Volunteer Training.
- 4. Complete Laundry Training/Shadowing.

### TIME AND PLACE:

To be performed at our Moiliili Campus. Shifts available every day 8am-11am, 11am-2pm, 2pm-5pm, 5pm-8pm. \*More help needing Monday-Friday.\*

# **COMMITMENT:**

Three hours per week for a minimum of 3 months.

# **SUPERVISION:**

Direct supervision by Animal Caregivers, Assistant Animal Care Manager, and Animal Care Manager; indirect supervision by the Manager of Volunteer Services.
