

VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION Dog Walking Level 1

MAJOR OBJECTIVE:

 To provide daily exercise and interaction with adult dogs by taking them on walks.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Take adult dogs that are available for adoption on walks for exercise and restroom breaks.
- 2. Spot-clean dog kennel areas and other tasks, as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

*This role includes an additional fee for supplies.

- 1. Independent volunteers must be 18 years of age or older. Adult/Youth teams allowed; must be at least 8 years of age.
- 2. Must have no limitations that would prevent handling or working with animals.
- 3. Must be able to perform physically rigorous work, stand for entire shift and lift up to 30 pounds.

TRAINING:

- 1. Complete General Volunteer Application Process
- 2. Interview with the Volunteer Services team
- Complete General Animal Handling Training
- 4. Complete same day, in-person Dog Walking Level 1 Training and Shadow Shift

TIME AND PLACE:

- To be performed at our Mōʻiliʻili Campus
- Shifts available every day, 7 am- 10 am and 3 pm- 6 pm
- Dog Walking Level 1 Training available the third Saturday of every month from 8 – 11 am.



VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION Dog Walking Level 1

COMMITMENT:

• Three hours per week for a minimum of 3 months

SUPERVISION:

- Direct supervision by Behavior Manager
- Indirect supervision by the Volunteer Services Coordinator & Manager

BENEFITS:

- 3. Develop skills, such as animal handling and teamwork
- 4. The ability to make an animal's time in our care more enjoyable and comfortable
