VOLUNTEER ROLE DESCRIPTION

Pounce Hawaii Lounge Crew

MAJOR OBJECTIVE:

- To support Pounce Hawaii's staff to clean and prepare the cat lounge areas for the public to meet and potentially adopt Hawaiian Humane Society cats and kittens.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Cleaning the two cat lounge rooms, which includes changing litter, providing fresh food, water and disinfecting areas.
2. Provide enrichment to the cats and kittens.
3. Notify a staff member of suspected health issues and behavior, if observed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Volunteers must be 18 years of age or older
2. Must have no limitations that would prevent handling or working with cats
3. Must be able to perform physically rigorous work, stand for entire shift and lift up to 50 pounds
4. Good communication skills
5. Ability to work independently

TRAINING:

1. Complete General Volunteer Application Process.
2. Interview with the Volunteer Services team.
3. Complete in-person Pounce Hawaii Morning Cat Cleaning Crew Training.

TIME AND PLACE:

- To be performed at Pounce Hawaii in Kakaako.
- Shifts available daily, 7 – 8:30 am.
- Trainings available the first Wednesday of the month from 6-8 pm.

COMMITMENT:

- 1.5 hours per week for a minimum of 3 months.
